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Fundraising – *The Boosters lend support to our directors in myriad ways, including raising funds. The district is able to fund teacher salaries only! Music, stands, chairs, etc. are “extras”. We are grateful to our school community families for contributing and raising the funds that make this program strong. We also have supportive partners in the Ballard PTSA, Ballard High Foundation, and local businesses who support us with grants and sponsorships. It does take a village!*

Student Annual Fee \$135.00 due September 15th 2017.

The student-paid annual fee goes to the Associated Student Body (ASB) fund. ASB funds are held by the school, not the boosters. The annual fee is spent on operating expenses like sheet music, festival fees, transportation, t-shirts, instrument repair, and uniform cleaning. ASB funds are restricted and cannot be spent to pay for items like coaches, clinicians or guest instructors. (If you need help to pay the annual fee please fill out the scholarship form.)

BPA Booster Club Fundraising - ongoing

Booster funds can pay for coaches, clinicians, guest instructors and student scholarships, which are the bulk of the BHS Performing Arts Booster Club budget. These funds are also used for uniforms, office supplies and printing, and other expenses of the program. Funds for this budget come from our events, matching funds, sponsorships, merchandise sales, and passive fundraising. The Booster Club also sponsors fundraising events for students to help raise money for their ASB/student accounts. These funds can be used to pay for trips and camps.
